The Massachusetts Antique Fire Apparatus Association is pleased to welcome all members back to New England for the Summer Conference. We have a great week of events planned and hope to see our friends come together from across the country and Canada to enjoy some New England fire apparatus.

We have nightly speakers scheduled as well as 2 bus tours and full muster day planned that includes on-site pumping from a porta-tank, a mid-day seminar on apparatus restoration, a firematic fleamarket. The Saturday evening member banquet will include a local guest speaker on fire apparatus photography following the apparatus show.



The Host Hotel is the Royal Trade Plaza Best Western, located at 181 Boston Post Rd, directly off Rt20, only a few miles off Rt495, Exit 63B in Marlborough. The hotel and conference center has ample rooms and meeting spaces, as well as a large parking lot to securely park your apparatus for the week. Daily breakfast, a heated indoor pool, arcade, and on-site bar/pub is sure to keep everyone fed and entertained when not attending conference events. In the immediate area are numerous other shopping, eating, and entertainment venues.

Room Rate for the hotel is \$149/night for the week, with both King and Double rooms available. Reservations can be made by visiting www.massmafaa.com and using the posted link, or by calling the hotel directly at (508) 460-0700. Mention the MASS ANTIQUE FIRETRUCK CONFERENCE to get the special rate. **Hotel discount rate cut-off is July 24th.** Marlborough is located in Central Massachusetts, the closest airports to the conference center are **Worcester-Regional (ORH)** approximately 30min to the South, or **Boston Logan (BOS)** which is 45 minutes East.

BUS TRIP 1: MFA Stow/Heritage Museum. The first tour starts off at the Massachusetts State Fire Academy in Stow, where a tour of the state of the art facility will be conducted with an opportunity to see new recruits in action on the training grounds and plenty of apparatus to photograph. There may also be a stop at local firehouse to view their apparatus. Lunch on your own in downtown Hudson, MA where there are numerous eateries to satisfy your hunger. Hudson FD on Washington St. houses a 1938 Buffalo. Following lunch will be a stop at the American Heritage Museum, which features one of the worlds largest tank and military vehicle collections. Vehicles are displayed in unique dioramas and immersive exhibits. Museum passes are included in the cost of the tour. While at the museum, local in-service apparatus will rotate through as well.

BUS TRIP 2: Uxbridge Museum/Worcester Firehouses. Our Friday tour starts with trip to the historic milltown of Uxbridge, where you will visit the recently restored 1904 firehouse, where over 2,500 artifacts have been collected and preserved. The Uxbridge Fire Museum is home to both a 1937 Maxim 500/150 pumper and a 1940 Seagrave 500/500 pumper. Following the museum will be an opportunity to view and photograph area in-service apparatus just down the road. Next will be the trek to the City of Worcester, where we will make a stop at the Franklin Street station, which was built on the site of the Worcester Cold Storage Warehouse fire, where 6 members were lost in 1999. A memorial in there honor is adjacent to the house. Lunch (on your own) will be at the renovated and expanded Wormtown Brewery. Following lunch will be a stop at the Grove Street Station and Training facility, where a plethoera of Worcester apparatus will be on display for all the buffs to photograph.

Saturdays On-Site Muster will feature numerous trophies for all different types of apparatus. No need to commute, just walk right outside. During the event, a special presentation “The Restoration Process” will be given by Fire Apparatus restorer John Gasper of Gaspers Automotive Restorations. He will be displaying a 1926 Seagrave City Service Ladder. Pumping opportunities will be provided by a local fire departments Porta-Tank. Vendors will have numerous booths with antiques and firematic memorabilia.

Following the Muster will be our Annual Member Banquet, with your choice of plated meal's of either Boneless Stuffed Chicken w/ Cranberry Apple Stuffing, New England Scrod, or Vegetable Pasta Primavera. All meals include Warm rolls, a seasonal soup, salad, and coffee/tea with a dessert. The banquet's keynote speaker will be Michael Boynton, of Massfiretrucks.com. Michael will be showing off his collection of Fire Apparatus throughout the years and giving tips on how to get the perfect shot of your rig.
